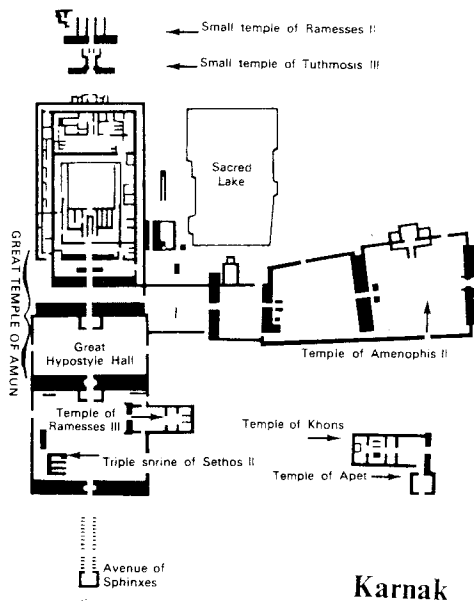

TOURS 1992-1993

NORTHERN GREECE AND TURKEY 1-28 OCTOBER, 1992.

This tour, led by Miss Joan Beck, will visit Athens - Meteora - Vergina - Pella and Thessaloniki in Greece; Troy - Istanbul - Boghazkoy - Alacahuyuk - Kultepe - Goreme Valley - Izmir (ancient Smyrna) - Ephesus and Bodrum (ancient Halicarnassus) in Turkey; the island of Samos and a tour of Aegina, Poros and Hydra, as well as other sites.
